



## GDPR AND PRIVACY STATEMENT FOR ACCIDENT COMPENSATION CLAIMS

(articles 13 and 14, EU Regulation No. 2016/679)

Autostrada del Brennero S.p.A., in its capacity as Data Controller, wishes to inform you, pursuant to articles 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) No. 679 of 27 April 2016, aka "General Data Protection Regulation" ("GDPR"), that the data provided by way of the "Accident compensation claim" forms, "Station damage reports", or as otherwise provided (via emails, letters, etc.), as well as any data obtained from other sources available to our Company, with regard to specific events, will be processed by us as follows:

### 1. Purpose and legal basis of the processing

The data will be processed for management and administrative purposes relative to the accident compensation claim and related insurance practices, as well as to handling any litigation which may arise. The legal bases of the processing are the consent freely given by you and the legitimate interest of the Data Controller in ensuring the protection of the Company. Please note that we cannot initiate the claims procedure without your consent.

### 2. Provision and storage of data

Personal data is required to initiate the claims procedure and for the related insurance practices (the data marked with the symbol \* in the website form are compulsory). Other data, where relevant, may be required to complete the description of the event for insurance purposes. If not provided, you may be asked to provide additional information at a later stage.

The data will be processed until the conclusion of the procedure, after which it will be retained for the length of time provided by the applicable legislation on the retention of documents for administrative, accounting, tax, contractual and insurance purposes.

The data may also be retained to protect the data subject or the Company in the event of judicial actions, until the end of the period within which a legal action may be brought or until the end of the relevant legal process, in case of litigation under way.

### 3. Recipients of personal data

Personal data will be processed by authorised, suitably trained personnel working under the authority and responsibility of the Data Controller. The information will be forwarded to insurance companies for fulfilling the relevant practices and, in the case of judicial actions, to the persons operating in the administrative/judicial sector, to the counterparties and their appointed legal counsels, to panels of arbitrators and, generally speaking, to all the parties who need the data to properly fulfil the above-mentioned purposes and in accordance with the applicable legislation.

Personal data may also be processed by third parties providing services related to the said purposes, such as communication, email, mail delivery, IT, etc., services. However, only the data strictly necessary for the performance of the relative functions will be communicated to these parties.

### 4. Data subject's rights

The data subject may at any time exercise the rights provided for in Chapter III of the GDPR. In particular, the data subject has the right to ask the Data Controller to access the data concerning him/her, to rectify or erase the data, including the right to have incomplete personal data completed by providing a supplementary statement, as well as the right to restriction of processing; to receive the data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format; to object, in whole or in part, to the use of the data; and to exercise other rights recognised to him/her by the applicable legislation. The data subject also has the right, at any time, to withdraw the consent given. These rights may be exercised by writing to the Data Protection Officer (DPO) by post. Pursuant to article 77 of the GDPR, the data subject also has the right to lodge a complaint with the Personal Data Protection Authority if he/she considers that the processing infringes the said GDPR.
